Bob Heggie was appointed Chief Executive of the Alberta Utilities Commission in January 2008. In his current role, Bob is responsible for leading the implementation of overall organizational strategy and day-to-day operations to ensure achievement of the Commission's organizational objectives.

Prior to his appointment as Chief Executive, Bob Heggie was Executive Manager of the Utilities Branch of the Alberta Energy and Utilities Board. In that role, Bob was responsible for delivery of the Board's utility regulatory mandate, with particular focus on gas and electricity restructuring issues. Previous to his appointment as Executive Manager, Bob was Associate General Counsel in the Board's Law Branch. In his practice with the Board, Bob provided counsel to the Board in matters touching on all aspects of the Board's mandate including pipelines, processing facilities, oil sands, equitable relief, coal mines and environmental issues.

He is the co-chair of the Energy Law Forum, the CAMPUT Energy Regulation course and the Energy Regulatory Forum. He is a contributing author to Canadian Energy Law and Policy.
