Erin Mansur is the Revers Professor of Business Administration at the Tuck School of Business at Dartmouth and a research associate at the National Bureau of Economic Research. His interests are in the fields of industrial organization and environmental economics, focusing primarily on questions regarding energy markets and energy policy.

Recent papers examine how hydrofracking affects local employment and wages, how low natural gas prices affect emissions from the electricity industry, and how charging electric cars affects emissions from the electricity industry. He previously taught at Yale SOM, Yale FES, and Dartmouth economics. He holds a B.A. from Colby College and a Ph.D. in Economics from the University of California at Berkeley.
