Key Staff and Responsibiliti


Continuity of leadership is critical to ensure continuity of essential functions. Organizations should provide for a clear line of succession in the absence of existing leadership and the necessary delegations of authority to ensure that succeeding leadership has the legal and other authorities to carry out their duries.

Orders of Succession

Local Governments are responsible for establishing, promulgating, and maintaining orders of succession to key positions. Such orders of succession are an essential part of an organization's continuity of operations plan to ensure that organization essoned know who assumes the authority and responsibility of the organization's leadership that leadership is incapacitated or becomes otherwise unavailable during a continuity situation. Orders should be of sufficient depth to ensure that the organization can manage and direct its essential functions and operations throughout any emergency.


