The City of Calgary's Long Range Transportation Plans

- Calgary Transportation Plan (CTP) & Municipal Development Plan > 30 year blueprint
- Transportation Infrastructure Investment Plan (TIIP) > 10 year project plan

CTP

- Represents a balanced suite of mobility choices
 - Ped
 - Cycle
 - Public transit
 - Goods movement
 - Auto
- Goods movement is a key component



- R34 Macleod & 162 Ave interchange
- R35 Sarcee Tr. Corridor improvements
- R36 Country Hill Blvd widening
- R37 Beddington Tr widening
- R38 36 St. NE widening
- R39 Crowchild & Flanders interchange
- R40 TCH & Bowfort Rd interchange

Funding Sources

- Largely Provincial
- Special programs great but they fluctuate (AMIP, MSI)
- Fuel tax is the only ongoing source

Sustainment

- Ongoing operations and maintenance is under funded
- Operations of system and seasonal maintenance
- Fuel tax is the only ongoing source
- Millrate sources compete against all
