"The Role of Energy Regulation in Making the Transition to a Sustainable Energy Future"

Dr. Michal Moore is the Chief Economist for the United States National Renewable Energy Laboratory and a former energy regulator in California. Michal will address the 'Role of Energy Regulation in Making the Transition to a Sustainable Energy Future'.

Dr. Moore will discuss the convergence of energy markets and the regulatory strategies necessary to deal with extraction, generation and transmission of energy supplies in a world where there is disparity between the situs of energy sources and emerging demand. He will frame his remarks in the context of the evolution necessary to allow free and open competition between industries and the regulatory oversight necessary to prevent market manipulation while encouraging critical capital investment.
