Bissett School of Business

1911

- Mount Royal began offering business and commercial studies courses in 1911
- Early history of responding to community need



Transportation & Business - History

1970

- Mount Royal began offering an integrated aviation diploma combining academics and flight training
- Program transferred to Business in the 90s & program shifted to integrate business & science



Aviation in 2010

- Now over 1,300 Mount Royal Aviation Diploma graduates from diploma
 - Including over 400 who were or are employed by Air Canada
 - Pilots in Military
 - F18's and Snowbirds
 - Image from 4 MRU grads who recently found themselves flying in the north

Alberta Aerospace Infrastructure

- Vast network serving Alberta's communities
 - 72 regional airports
 - 12 municipal airports
 - 2 international airports
 - 1 military airport
- As well as,
 - Ambulance, forest fire suppression, agriculture related activities, remote sensing, aerial mapping & creational flying

Example: Calgary International Airport

- Offers service to over 60 destinations.
- Over 12.2 million passengers in 2007
- Over 12.2 million passengers passed through the airport
- Major cargo hub
 - Cargo can be shipped anywhere in the world in 48 hours from Calgary
- An economic engine with value of \$1 billion in exports

Logistics, Supply Chain, Transportation

- Partnered with industry/community in proposal development
- Area identified as one of need
 - 85,000 employees identified in 2000
 - 117,000 employees identified in sector today
- Built linkages to aviation / transportation
- Approval from Government March 2003
 - Launched Supply Chain Fall 2003
- 140 students in program
- Academic integrated Work Experience plus 30 academic courses
- Professional partnerships and accreditation
 - Example Credit with Canadian Institute of Traffic and Transportation
 - Sector Council accreditation 1st university in Canada






