This initial assignment was expanded to include Logistec operations throughout the Atlantic Region, focusing on Business Development and Customer Service in all marine transportation sectors.

In June of 2004, Andrew joined the management team at the Saint John Port Authority, assuming responsibility for all Marketing and Operational activities. He currently holds the position of Senior Vice President, Trade and Business Development, and his current responsibilities include Cargo, Cruise, and Venues Business Development, as well as Property Management and Strategic Port initiatives.

Andrew completed the requirements to receive the CITT Certified Logistics Professional (CCLP) designation in 1989, and completed the Executive Marketing Management course at Western University in 1991.
