Joyce Henry is the Director General, Marine Policy at Transport Canada, responsible for policy advice to the Canadian Government on matters related to international and domestic shipping, ports and the St. Lawrence Seaway.

Ms. Henry has lead a number of key files for Transport Canada, both domestically and internationally, including advising the Minister of Transport on fulfilling critical mandate commitments related to safe marine shipping and coastal protection, ferry services in Canada, and ports' policy. Ms. Henry joined Transport Canada in 2013 and held the position of Executive Director to the Deputy Minister of Transport, Infrastructure and Communities prior to joining the Marine Policy Directorate in October 2014.

Previously, Ms. Henry worked in a number of other federal government agencies, including at the Privy Council Office, Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency. Ms. Henry is a member of the Consultative Shipping Group, an international forum of marine nations that collaborate to resolve marine related files and the President of the Asia Port Services Network. Ms. Henry has a Bachelor of Journalism with Combined Honours in Political Science from Carleton University and enjoys sport and reading.
